Who do we help?

Average household size = 2.5

39% Farmington, 9% Aztec, 11% Bloomfield/Blanco, 28% Reservation and 8% Other.

5% identified themselves as homeless, 40% at zero income

Ethnicity: Caucasian 23%, Native American 53%, Hispanic 14%, Black & other 5%.

ECHO Food Bank

- Individuals and households (40% under age 18) received 966,761 pounds of non-perishable & 337,750 of perishable foods, (an estimated 1.5 .million meals) in 140 special diet boxes, 1098 holiday food boxes, 2501 crisis food boxes and in 5221 backpacks food for kids in 24 area schools.;
- Agency Surplus Foods 22 partner agency (soup kitchens, shelters and food pantries) & 5 emergency distribution partners received 391,250 pounds of non-federal food with a retail value of \$676,863 (but only cost agencies \$11,054). Partners also received 77,698 pounds of TEFAP federal commodities (valued at \$56,719) free of charge;
- The Emergency Food Assistance Program (USDA TEFAP) provided 363,330 pounds of perishable and non-perishable foods to 26,332 income qualified households;
- The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (USDA) provided 94,828 food boxes to 9,921 seniors, at 63 monthly sites, with 2,639,001 pounds of nutritious foods;
- Our generous and hard working community made it happen. Non-Federal donations included 1,033,005 pounds of food and non-food & \$245,469 in monetary grants & donations. Donated volunteer hours totaled 14,370 potentially saving us \$201,029 in labor costs. Our donation records are kept on file and our donor privacy policy is available for review.

ECHO Pre-School

In 2017 ECHO **Aztec Pre-School** had 87 unduplicated children enrolled of which 28 were latch key. On a Daily basis children were served two meals, breakfast and lunch, and one snack. We served 5,803 breakfasts and 5,887 lunches, totaling to 11,690 meals. Our snack total was 8,695
